## Liver Transplantation for Unresectable Neuroendocrine Tumour Liver Metastases: Central MDT Members and Responsible Clinicians Contract

Liver transplantation for NET LM is being performed as a pilot programme. The safety and success of the programme will depend on the expertise and commitment of involved clinicians. It is imperative that they understand the basics of NET management and liver transplantation so that we can gather evidence of transplant benefit.

NETs are rare cancers that are poorly studied due to lack of funding for research. This pilot provides a perfect opportunity for raising the profile of NET patients to attract funding for high quality research and trials. Delivering on this potential will rely on diligence and commitment of involved clinicians to provide the necessary data and participate in audits, trials and basic research. Clinicians shall only be allowed to participate in the pilot if they can commit to these requirements.
